Excise Tax on Jewellery

The excise tax has been removed on imported jewellery, clocks and articles made of semi-precious stones, with a date of release on or after May 2, 2006. Please refer to the Canada Revenue Agency " Notice to all licensed jewellery manufacturers and wholesalers under the Excise Tax Act and to importers " at <http://www.cra-arc.gc.ca/E/pub/et/ets155/ets155-e.html> for further details.
