1. Air - Fuel surcharge increases coming Mid May

The average price for aviation fuel has increased again to go beyond the 190-point threshold, thus triggering a further fuel surcharge. So far, some airline carriers have advised an increase which took effect May 10, 2004 –as follows:

- Domestic to CAD 0.20/kg
- International and Transborder to CAD 0.26/kg.

No doubt, other Airlines, Carriers and even local drayage and delivery companies will follow suit in the very near future. ITN will keep you updated on any changes to this surcharge.

3. ITN - Weekly Consolidated Service from Vietnam and Cambodia

ITN is pleased to announce a weekly consolidated service from Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam to Toronto / Montreal. Closing every Monday from HCM City, sails Tuesday and arrives Toronto / Montreal (via Vancouver) 35 days thereafter. Included is an allowance of 1 week transit from Vancouver to Toronto / Montreal. Feeder service from SIH Cambodia to HCM City adds about 5 days to total transit time.
