

CBSA Payment Options:

Importers are now responsible for arranging payments directly to the CBSA as of Oct. 21, 2024.

CBSA issues their Statement of Account (SOA) on the 25th of each month which can be found through the “Financial Information” link in the CARM Client Portal (CCP), main page. Payment options with CBSA are listed below:

All payments must be made in Canadian Currency.

1) Online banking via your financial institution:

Step 1: Select the correct account:

Use your importer's BN15 number (for example, 123456789RM0001) as your account number (not the Canada Revenue Agency RT account number).

Step 2: Add the correct recipient (Payee):

- CBSA Duties Taxes Fees
- CBSA Duties, Taxes and Fees
- Canada Border Services Agency
- Agence des Services Frontaliers du Canada
- ASFC droits taxes frais

Please contact your financial institution directly concerning any questions regarding the CBSA “Payee” name.

2) Pre-Approved Debit (PAD): Set up through the CARM Client Portal (main page):

Importers who want to register for PAD payments need to have an account with a Canadian institution. Participating institutions are listed here: <https://www.payments.ca/our-directories/financial-institutions-branch-directory>.

- 3) Credit Card Payments:** Actioned through the CCP (“Financial Information” link – “Transaction History” link). The transaction limit is \$4,999.99 based on the total account balance due payable; multiple credit card transactions are not accepted for balances exceeding \$4,999.99.

4) Payment by Cheque via Courier or Mail:

Make all cheques payable to the “**Receiver General for Canada**” and send cheques to:

Include a copy of the first page of the Statement of Account with the cheque. Ensure that the copy shows legibly the RM account number against which the payment is to be applied.
