

RPP Surety Bonds through ITN Customs

Bond Premiums (Note: Minimum Bond Level is \$5,000.00 CAD)

Bond Premium Rate: \$6.75 CAD/1,000.00 of bond amount (Inclusive of taxes).

Bond premium rate subject to following minimum bond premiums:

Bonds of \$5,000.00 @ \$375.00 CAD

Bonds greater than \$5,000.00 @ \$475.00 CAD

Bond Endorsement Fees for Bond Level Increases:

Bond levels up to \$100,000.00 not requiring financials by Surety for review/approval = \$75.00 CAD

Bond Levels greater than \$100,000.00 requiring financials by Surety for review/approval = \$125.00 CAD

Above rates applicable to Bond applications received on or after Nov. 1st, 2025.

Bonds are automatically renewed each anniversary and invoiced by ITN Customs.

Importer clients may complete the accompanying ITN Customs (fillable) “RPP Surety Bond Application Form” and return it to: bonds@itncustoms.com

Completion of the “ITN Customs” RPP Surety Bond Application Form” constitutes the applicant’s authorization for ITN Customs to procure a “Financial Security Agreement” (Bond) on their behalf.

CBSA has posted “Calculated Security Requirement” amounts in CARM. This amount is found on the “Financial Security Dashboard” through the “Financial Security” link under “Financial Information”, CARM main menu. Please insert this amount in the space provided on the “ITN Customs RPP Surety Bond Application Form”. This amount will be used to calculate the Bond level (50% of the Calculated Security requirement amount).

Upon approval, the “Importer Authorizer” (Corporate Officer) indicated on the bond application will receive an email from our Surety “Intact Insurance” C/O NFP Canada Corp.- ITN Logistics, to execute signature for issuance of the bond. Bonds will be uploaded electronically to CARM by Intact Insurance via API technology.

Please include applicant name in the email subject line when returning the bond application.
